The Program

1ST YEAR WEBELOS

1st year Webelos will attend Activity Badge sessions taught by adults and Scouters. They all have considerable knowledge and experience in the subject matter they are teaching. These sessions are very much like what the boys will experience visiting a merit badge counselor as a Boy Scout.



Although most of the subject matter necessary for a WEBELOS to earn the activity badge will be covered we cannot guarantee that 100% of the badge work will be completed at the end of each session. It is up to the den leaders and adults accompanying the Scouts to record everything completed.

This is a great opportunity for first year WEBELOS Den leaders to get a big assist in their den's program.

2ND YEAR WEBELOS



All sessions in this part of our program are designed to introduce second year WEBELOS Scouts to the exciting things they will be doing once they have crossed over to a Boy Scout troop. You will notice that all of the instructional presentations in the program are given by Boy Scouts. Many of these Scouts have attended this event as Webelos! This will show your WEBELOS that they too can learn and master these skills. If you look around you may see Scouts teaching who were in your pack last year!

The areas to be covered are:

**FIRE BUILDING, WOODS TOOLS, ROPES, KNOTS & SPLICES, FIND YOUR WAY,
COOKING IN CAMP AND LET'S GO CAMPING I**

The Scouts will complete many of the requirements necessary for the **OUTDOORSMAN BADGE** this weekend. 2nd year Webelos may also be able to use it to meet the "Attend a Boy Scout Activity" requirement for the Arrow of Light.

Every year there are questions regarding whether a WEBELOS Scout can attend this or any camping adventure without a parent or guardian in attendance. To help clarify this issue we are including the following excerpt from the WEBELOS Handbook:

"The WEBELOS den leader cannot be expected to take full responsibility for the health and safety of six or eight boys at an overnight campout. In most cases, each WEBELOS Scout will be under the supervision of a parent or guardian. In all cases, each WEBELOS Scout is to be responsible to a specific adult. Boy Scouts of America Health and Safety and Youth Protection guidelines apply. If you (meaning the parent) or another adult family member cannot attend, find a responsible adult to go with your son"

Under no circumstances should the WEBELOS den leader be this person. If you need further clarification of this requirement please contact Batavia Council Service Center or the Lockport Field Office.
